## Is there a housing shortage in Sundbyberg?

Yes. According to the municipality itself, there is a housing shortage. Sundbyberg is growing quickly and demand for more housing is increasing. The municipality **has no target** for how much to build, but according to Region Stockholm, Sundbyberg must complete construction of **1,000** homes per year until 2030 in order to manage the housing shortage.

Continued construction and reasonable rental rates are required for everyone to afford a home.

On 13 September, you can take part in deciding which political parties will shape housing policy and make decisions about our homes. Your vote makes a difference.









































